

RESTRUCTURING OF SERVICES

Sunday School Classes

- **Children and adult Sunday school classes will not meet Sunday, May 10, 17, and 24.**
 - Each class that has been broadcasting virtual classes is asked to continue on Sunday evenings from 5:00 p.m. until 5:45 p.m.
 - There are three adult Sunday school classes that have been meeting on the church property throughout the quarantine, and they may continue meeting at the same time and place for these weeks.
 - There will be a class held in the Main Auditorium to serve as an overflow, if other adult Sunday school classes are full.
 - A children's Sunday school class will be broadcast at 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on Sundays.
- **On Sunday, May 31, all Sunday school classes for those four years old and older will resume.**
 - Social distancing will need to be practiced in each Sunday school class and department.
 - Each teacher will be asked to clean their classroom when finished with class.
 - On Sunday, May 17, Pastor will meet with all Sunday school teachers, superintendents, and Junior Church workers in the front of the Main Auditorium after the morning service regarding details of opening Sunday school departments.

Sunday Morning Services

- Beginning Sunday, May 10, we will have on-property services from 10:45 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
- Attendees should enter and exit the building through the door closest to where they parked.
- Doors will be propped open to avoid touching door handles.
- Attendees will be greeted and directed to a seat in the auditorium to ensure social distancing.
- Household units (those who live in the same house) will be allowed to sit together per the Governor's recommendations.
- There will be a delayed dismissal at the end of each service.

Sunday Evening Services

- No evening services will be held in the Main Auditorium on Sunday, May 10, 17, and 24, to allow time to clean and sanitize the building.
- Evening services will be livestreamed.
- Anyone wanting to come to the property will be directed to the AOB to watch the livestream.
- Evening services will resume in the Main Auditorium on Sunday, May 31, at 6:00 p.m.
 - Attendees should enter and exit the building through the door closest to where they parked.
 - Doors will be propped open to avoid touching the door handles.
 - Attendees will be greeted and directed to a seat in the auditorium to ensure social distancing.
 - Household units (those who live in the same house) will be allowed to sit together per the Governor's recommendations.
 - There will be a delayed dismissal at the end of each service.

Wednesday Evening Services

- Wednesday evening services will continue to be livestreamed through Wednesday, May 27.
- Anyone wanting to come to the property will be directed to the AOB to watch the livestream.
- There will be no children's choir practices until further notice.
- Wednesday evening services in the Main Auditorium will begin meeting on Wednesday, June 3, at 7:00 p.m.
 - Attendees should enter and exit the building through the door closest to where they parked.

- Doors will be propped open to avoid touching the door handles.
- Attendees will be greeted and directed to a seat in the auditorium to ensure social distancing.
- Household units (those who live in the same house) will be allowed to sit together per the Governor's recommendations.
- There will be a delayed dismissal at the end of each service.

Nurseries

- No nurseries will be provided for any service from Sunday, May 10, through Wednesday, June 10.
- All families are encouraged to sit together in the Main Auditorium.
- If needed, the West Overflow Room will be available as a "cry room" for families with small children.
- Nurseries will be available on Sunday, June 14.
- Strict sanitation guidelines will be followed after each service to ensure proper cleaning.

Bus Routes

- No bus routes will be run until further notice.
- All bus workers are encouraged to continue visiting their routes.
- Workers visiting bus routes in Illinois should consider following the restrictions put in place by Governor Pritzker.

Transformer Kids' Club

- TKC will start its summer session on Wednesday, June 17.
- Social-distancing guidelines will be implemented.
- Each location will be cleaned to prepare for the services on Sunday.

Choir and Orchestra

- There will be no choir or orchestra performances from Sunday, May 10, through Sunday, June 28.
- Beginning Sunday, July 5, there will be a downsized choir and orchestra following social-distancing guidelines.
- Please await further instructions from your ministry leader.

Social Distancing

Everyone is asked to please follow the social distancing guidelines that have been established by the CDC and recommended by the Governor of Indiana.

- Please maintain a 6-foot distance from anyone not in your household unit.
- Avoid shaking hands with others.
- Congregating in the hallways before or after church will not be permitted.
- All church-sponsored meetings should follow these guidelines.

Facial Coverings

While it is not required, the Governor strongly recommends that all individuals wear a face covering when in public.

Additional Requests and Measures

- There will be no bulletins or handouts until further notice.
- There will be no songbooks in the pews; the words will be displayed on the screens.
- Hand-sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the hallways.
- Anyone age 65 and over and people who have underlying health conditions or compromised immune systems are encouraged to consider staying home and to continue watching the services online.
- Everyone is asked to check their own temperature before attending services; anyone with a fever of 100.3 or higher in the previous 72 hours is asked to remain home and watch the services online.
- The Foundations Bookstore will reopen on Sunday, May 31, with a limited selection.
- Everyone is encouraged to give online, and safe protocols will be established to take offerings during the services.
